U.S. Immigration is Out of Control

The numbers tell the story

Phyllis Schlafly in her continuing series of powerful articles on illegal immigration in *The Phyllis Schlafly Report* tells of the effects and politics of illegal immigration on our people and the U.S.

The following notes are designed to complement those chronicles by giving the statistics behind the problem. Consider the following an appendix to Phyllis' work. In order to understand "illegal immigration," it is first necessary to understand what has constituted legal immigration in "recent" U.S. history.

In spite of U.S. law setting quotas for legal immigration, the numbers of legal immigrants have exploded in recent history. There appears to be no relation between actual persons entering the country and the quotas established by law. (See the numbers, below) The tidal wave of Mexican humanity swarming over the U.S. borders illegally needs to be understood in terms of its actual magnitude. Yet, more explosively, when the issue of illegal immigration into the U.S. is considered in terms of Mexican demographics [Mexico has been a massive baby machine.], the problem becomes even worse. Largely not addressed is that other sources of illegal humanity swarming to the shores of the U.S. compound the problem. In short immigration is totally out of control in the U.S.



Immigration Quotas

The 1980 Refugee Act set the basic legal U.S. immigration quota at 270,000 per year from ALL COUNTRIES. On Nov. 6, 1986, the "Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986" was signed into law. It was an amnesty act for illegals, who had been in the U.S. PRIOR to 1982. It has been estimated that 3 million people were legalized, based on that legislation.

The great reason, which "sold" the bill to the country, was: "since they're here, we might as well make them legal." Also, the law was touted at the time as "solving the problem." This was based on em-

ployer sanctions for hiring illegals. In other words, "cut off the incentive for a job, and the problem will go away." The Immigration Act of 1990 Act raised the quota to 700,000 for 3 years. After 3 years, the quota was to fall to 675,000 after 1995. Technically, that is where the quota for legal immigration into the U.S. stands, even in 2004.

The 1987 World Almanac, page 226, gives the statistics for legal Mexican immigration into the U.S. for the decade of the '70's. Total legal immigration from Mexico, 1971 to 1980, was 640 thousand, an average of 64,000 per year. Looking at the Numbers: It's bad during the four years of the Carter presidency, 1977 through 1980, the yearly immigration of foreigners from all countries into the U.S. averaged 513,686 people per year. [2003 Yearbook of Immigration Statistics, Department of Homeland Security].

During the eight years of Ronald Reagan's presidency, 1981 through 1988, the yearly average of immigration into the U.S. was 588,832 per year.

When George Bush ("42") took over from Reagan, the average jumped to 1,357,138 per year for his four years, 1989 through 1992. Then the Clinton years saw the flow into the U.S. ease to 786,784 per year for 8 years.

In 1995, the U.S. Commission on Immigration Reform had recommended that 550,000 legal immigrants from all sources into the U.S. annually was a number which could be accommodated by the country.

Under George "Dubya" Bush ("43") the flow of immigrants into the country was back up to 944,626 yearly for the first 3 years of his presidency.

Illegals Explode: It's worse

The number of illegal immigrants in the U.S. (mostly Mexican), and their rate of increase, is telling. The U.S. Select Commission on Immigration and Refugee Policy estimated that there were between 3.5 and 6 million illegals in the country in 1978 and that the numbers were increasing by 250,000 to 500,000 per year. The Office of Management and Budget esti-

mated that there were 6.25 million illegals in the country by 1984.

Moving forward in time to the present, there are various estimates of the total numbers of illegals in the U.S. In 1995, the U.S. Commission on Immigration Reform (established by the 1990 Act) "low balled the estimate" and guessed that there were 2.3 to 2.4 million "unauthorized residents." In 2002, Northwestern University estimated that there were 11 million illegals in the country. As of 2004, and as controversy spread with regard to the issue, the "doves," "lead" by the *Wall Street Journal*, estimated that there were 8 million illegals in the country [11-4-04, p. A4]. Some "hawks," such as the Federation for American Immigration Reform, estimated that there were 15 million illegals living in the country. *Time Magazine*, 9-15-04, p. 52, estimated 15 million, also.

Also, *Time Magazine*, in the same issue, stated, (p. 52), "It's fair to estimate, based on a *Time* investigation, that the number of illegal aliens flooding into the U.S. this year will total 3 million [mostly Mexicans coming across the southern U.S. border]."

The Mexican Volcano

While current discussion about the issue involves "what to do about the illegals already in the country" and "what to do about the open border," little is said about the rising tide of potential illegals and "illegals in-waiting" for the future.

Mexico is a third world country with a corrupt political and business establishment, which cannot accommodate its population explosion within the economy of the country. The emigration of millions of uneducated men and women to the U.S. is in fact a safety valve for the Mexican establishment.

Therefore, to the degree that the population continues to explode, the safety valve needs to be widened even more.

Consider that Mexico's population in the '70's went from 48.3 million to 65.8 million by 1980 (World Almanac). Of the total illegals in the U.S. by 1980, roughly 5 million could be ascribed to Mexico. By

Model Mexico to Clean up our Elections!

The United States has just experienced an election which broke records in voter participation. Sadly, however, we undoubtedly also broke records in countless voting irregularities as well as in deliberate machinations to falsify election results that would thwart the will of the people.

Before we are lulled into another three years of complacency, our country simply must correct these loopholes in our swiss-cheese election process. These loopholes can no longer be ignored, especially since, thanks to the awakened media and the internet bloggers who believe their candidate again had his election stolen from him, the issue is now front and center in the attention of our citizens.

No matter that President Bush won the popular vote by over three million votes... perception is reality. While many charges are false, many more are frighteningly accurate. As *Wall Street Journalist* John Fund says in his new book *Stealing Elections*, our voting process is the sloppiest of any among the industrialized nations of the world.

The issue that is at the heart of most of our voting concerns revolves around the issue of voter identification and proof of citizenship. Much of the current phantom voter base is largely the result of provisions of the Motor Voter Act of 1993 which prohibits any proof of voter existence or citizenship when registering to vote from government agencies such as the DMV, welfare offices, unemployment compensation agencies, or through the mail.

Additionally, only seventeen states require some sort of ID at the voting booth. Contrast this with Mexico where voters must produce photo hologram IDs and submit to thumbprint scanner checks as well as signature checks in order to vote. In thirty-three states in the U.S., registration gatherers or poll workers may be prosecuted on the grounds of harassment for even asking for proof of citizenship from a prospective voter.

Thus we have arrived at a point in the U.S. where registration gatherers are paid \$10 per registration, phony or real, and can have them all sent to a post office box for voting with no background checks required or permitted on the part of election officials processing the data. Motor Voter also disallows any purging of voter rolls for **eight years** after undeliverable postcards have been returned to boards of election. Non-voting voters are easy targets for the unscrupulous to detect in order to cast ballots on their behalf.

Any serious attempt to purge voter rolls of deadwood is invariably met with the "race card" indictment. Democrats cry, "Disenfranchisement!" which we heard at every turn from a complicit media during this election cycle. However, we enfranchised the illegal alien voter (along with felon, mentally handicapped, and nursing home assisted voting) as never before.

Front groups such as ACORN and Move-On.org are involved in these unscrupulous registrations. For example, illegal terrorist Nuradin Abdi (the suspected shopping mall bomb plotter from Somalia) was registered to vote by

ACORN in Ohio — along with al Qaeda agent Iyman Faris who planned to sabotage the Brooklyn Bridge. Florida's non-citizen terror suspect Sami Al-Arian cast a vote, a chilling reminder that at least eight of nineteen hijackers were eligible to vote in Virginia or Florida as they plotted to kill thousands of Americans.

Instead of obstructing all efforts to require voter ID and citizenship, Democrats would do well to join legitimate efforts clean up our elections. Democrats need to work with all political parties to require paper trails to provide audits for computer voting, clean up the chaos of provisional balloting at any precinct, stop the harassment and bullying of conservative voters trying to vote early in long computer voting lines, and denounce and prosecute uniformly, severely, and swiftly those conducting Republican headquarters break-ins as well as those caught registering or voting fraudulently. Instead, their party brings in foreign observers to determine any signs of voter disenfranchisement as the answer to all of our problems — and our prostrate State Department acquiesces in that ridiculous turn of events.

A recent Rasmussen poll discovered that 82% of Americans polled wanted proof of citizenship and ID to register and to vote. Even 75% of the Democrats polled agree. It's time to repeal Motor Voter, control our borders, and model Mexico in our voting process!

2000, with the Mexican population estimated at 95.8 million, over 10 million more could be logically extrapolated to be in the U.S. illegally. Now, with Time Magazine's projection of 3 million coming over the border in just one year, 2004, what can the future hold?

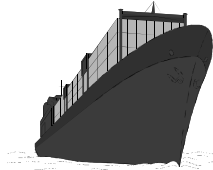
The *Economist Magazine's* 2002 edition of "World in Figures" listed the Mexican population "under 15" as 33.1% of the total population (p. 170). Extrapolating from current experience (vis a vis a population of nearly 100 million), there will be a pool of 33 million "prime" candidates (people 15 years old to 25

years old) for emigration into the U.S. over the next ten years. What percentage of that 33 million will try to enter the U.S. will depend on the economy of Mexico.

Worse yet, the full brunt of illegal immigration is not all from Mexican immigration. Not even addressed in the national media are the freighter ships full of

Chinese migrants interdicted off the Long Beach harbor in California. If the authorities catch entire shiploads of illegal Chinese, how many shiploads have in fact sneaked in undetected? Or, how many offload in Mexico and come over?

California – Physician Assisted Suicide Bill

Sacramento – Physician assisted suicide is back. Notwithstanding failed attempts in 1992 and 1999, physician assisted suicide is again being proposed to Californians.

Assembly Members Patty Berg (D – Santa Rosa) and Lloyd Levine (D – Van Nuys) will submit the second physician assisted suicide (PAS) bill in 5 years to the state legislature on or shortly after December 6th, the opening day of the 2005-2006 session.

The bill, as yet unnamed and unnumbered, will be modeled after the Oregon Death With Dignity Act. That law, passed in 1994, was initially ruled unconstitutional by a federal judge on grounds of unequal protection. The ruling was overturned in 1997 by the liberal 9th Circuit Court of Appeals. A subsequent initiative to repeal the law was rejected by Oregon voters in 1997 and Oregon became the first jurisdiction in the world to legalize physician assisted suicide.

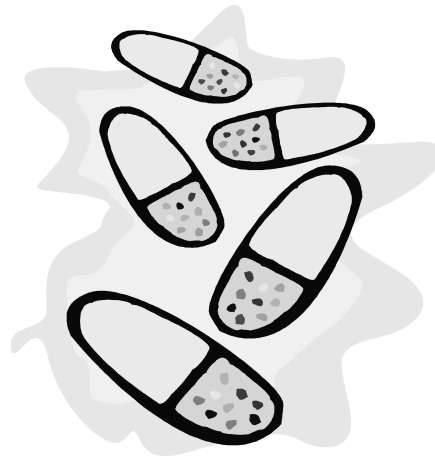
What does the Oregon law do?

It allows terminally ill patients to legally obtain a physician's lethal drug prescription to be self-administered. To qualify, the patient must

- be an adult of 18 years age or older
- be capable of making and communicating health care decisions
- have a terminal illness with less than 6 months to live
- be an Oregon resident
- voluntarily request the prescription for lethal drugs

Provisions to prevent abuse of PAS include:

- physicians must verify the patient is terminal, capable, and voluntarily requesting lethal drugs
- if depression or mental disorder is suspected, the patient shall be referred for counseling
- at least 48 hours shall elapse between written request and writing the prescription
- a patient may rescind his or her request at any time



Reporting requirements for prescribing and dispensing lethal drugs include:

- the physician must document compliance with PAS law in the patient's medical record
- the dispensing provider must file a dispensing record with the Oregon Health Services (OHS)
- such collected information shall not be public record or available to the public
- the OHS shall make public a statistical re-

port on collected information

Immunities, liabilities, and penalties for participating in PAS include:

- precluding criminal, civil or professional disciplinary action against participants in PAS acting in good faith
- making it a Class A felony to alter, forge, or coerce a request for lethal drug

The Oregon Death With Dignity Act does not assign enforcement authority to OHS or any other agency.

What are the results of the Oregon Death With Dignity Act?

Statistics from the Oregon Health Service and data prepared by Dr. Robert D. Orr, President of the Vermont Alliance for Ethical Health Care at www.vaeh.org/resources/index.shtml show that

- 171 patients committed physician assisted suicide compared with 53,544 Oregonians who died from the same underlying diseases from 1998 through 2003.
- 34% of Oregon doctors are willing to prescribe lethal drugs.
- 27% of Oregon doctors willing to prescribe lethal drugs admit they are not confident they can predict a 6-month prognosis.
- 6% of Oregon psychiatrists are confident they can diagnose depression after one visit.
- The first patient to die under the Act was refused prescription by her own and another doctor because she was depressed. The prescription was written by a Compassion in

Dying doctor.

- 75% of patients who have died received assistance from Compassion In Dying.
- The Act has no penalty for failure of doctors to submit reports.
- Reports to OHS have not included several cases of abuse, expansion, and complications reported by families to newspapers and not contested by proponents.
- The OHS has no regulatory authority or resources to detect under-reporting or non-compliance.
- The OHS admits they "cannot determine whether PAS is being practiced outside the framework of the Death With Dignity Act."

Some Observations on the Oregon experience with physician assisted suicide.

- 1) The vast majority of terminal patients opt for medical care, not physician assisted suicide.
- 2) Most doctors want to practice medicine, not physician assisted suicide.
- 3) There is no real safeguard against an incorrect 6-month terminal prognosis.
- 4) There is no real safeguard against a depression-driven request by the patient.
- 3) Compassion In Dying is a suicide advocacy group. Legalizing PAS is on their agenda.

4) Un-enforced and unregulated reporting protects PAS practitioners, not patients.

Some Observations on the proposed California physician assisted suicide bill.

- 1) California voters rejected Proposition 161 on physician assisted suicide in 1992.
- 2) In 1999 there were insufficient votes in the State Legislature to pass AB 1592, *The Death With Dignity Act*, (Aroner) which was modeled after the Oregon Death With Dignity Act.
- 3) Jack Kevorkian got a 10-25 year prison term for what AB 1592 offered.
- 4) AB 1592 put the elderly, disabled, and uninsured at risk of coercion to commit suicide instead of providing the compassionate care they need.
- 5) There is nothing in the Oregon experience to suggest an inherent patient need or desire for PAS.
- 6) Once legalized, suicide could be encouraged to preserve an inheritance, hide medical malpractice, or assure HMO profitability. It is impossible to safeguard against such misuse of legalized suicide.
- 7) In Holland, de facto physician-assisted suicide moved quickly from being voluntary to involuntary, with patients

being given lethal doses of drugs without their consent. Today, the vulnerable in Holland often forego needed hospitalization out of fear of being killed by the physician.

8) Physician assisted suicide is contrary to 3000 years of medical ethics and jeopardizes patient trust in the medical profession. Neither patient nor physician should be subjected to this perversion of medicine proposed by special interest groups and individuals.

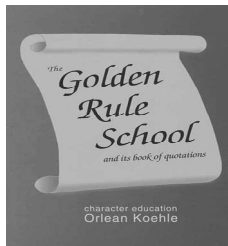
9) Assemblywoman Patty Berg successfully co-authored with Assemblywoman Lynn Daucher AB 1166, *Residential facilities: terminally ill persons*, which removes the need to call emergency response services such as 911 for hospice patients. AB 1166 was supported by the Compassion in Dying Federation. AB 1166 when coupled with Daucher's AB 1299, *Hospice*, which initially proposed to open hospice to patients with an incurable progressive illness, would have proved lethal to non-dying patients. Through persevering pro-life efforts, AB 1299 was ultimately de-funded and therefore AB 1166 muzzled.

California Eagle Leaders Become Published Authors to Combat Deceptive, Immoral Programs in Public Schools

The Golden Rule School and Its Book of Quotations

Because of their concern for the many programs promoting immorality and the homosexual agenda in their local schools, Orlean Koehle, State President of Eagle Forum of California and Georgiana Preskar, Director of Sacramento Eagle Forum, each decided to write a book about what they were finding out.



Orlean's book is called *The Golden Rule School and Its Book of Quotations*. It was motivated by a presentation she

witnessed at her son's high school in Santa Rosa, CA, by a group from the Human Rights Commission which asked for the high school to adopt their program called "Hate-Free Schools." To implement their program a certain number of teachers and students would have to go through diversity training which would teach them to be more tolerant of those who are different from themselves: blacks, Latinos, and acceptance of the homosexual lifestyle.

Orlean thought to herself. Why do we need such a program talking about hate? Why can't we just get back to teaching and living the Golden Rule, a simple rule that has served our schools and our nation well for over 200 years and taught civil-

ity, kindness, respect as they treat others as they would like to be treated.

Orlean gives suggestions for how a teacher can implement the teaching of the Golden Rule through the use of quotations which teach a moral truth. Half of the book lists these quotations with background information about the person who said them. A teacher writes a different quote on the board every morning and gives the assignment for the students to copy the quote into their journals, then to write a paragraph describing what it means to them. The teacher will then call on various students to read what they have written.

Orlean tried this method in several middle schools classrooms where she had remarkable results. The insight that some of the students wrote in their journals and the discussions that followed were quite profound, and little by little the students were being taught morality and character education, something many of them had not experienced before. It also set a very respectful and loving atmosphere in the classroom with very few discipline problems. At one of the schools the students in her English and History classrooms appreciated this teaching of morality so much they started a petition drive that all five classrooms signed and which they turned in to the principal. They were aware that Mrs. Koehle was there as a substitute just until a permanent teacher could be hired. But the petition was asking for Mrs. Koehle to be their permanent teacher because "Mrs. Koehle is teaching us great moral truths that we would not hear otherwise."

Orlean also discovered in her research for her book that the first page of California's Content Standards for elementary schools asks for the teaching of the "Golden Rule."

She also discovered there is an education code, 233.5a, on the books in California that states that all teachers should be teaching the "principles of morality, truth, justice, patriotism, and a true comprehension of the rights, duties, and dignity of American citizenship. To teach them to avoid idleness, profanity, and falsehood, and to instruct them in manners and morals and the principles of a free government."

There was a handbook printed to give out to all teachers to make sure they were trained and were aware that they were to be teaching morality and the other principles mentioned, but when the liberal Delaine Eastin became the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, she made sure that the handbooks were never distributed to the teachers. However, the ed code still exists and should still be governing what the teachers are teaching.

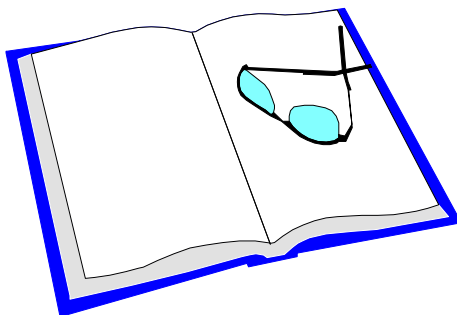
Seeds of Deception, Planting Destruction of America's Children

Georgiana Preskar's book *Seeds of Deception, Planting Destruction of America's Children*, is a well researched ex-

pose with over 400 footnotes. Georgiana's curiosity to find out why our country had changed so quickly, from the one she knew as a child, motivated her discovery of deception within the Elk Grove school district.

Her book is written as a journey as one secretive program led to the discovery of another. She writes about SEED, Seeking Educational Equity and Diversity, a behind the "closed" door school program that had been already deeply entrenched in Elk Grove's Schools which uses mind-control techniques to totally change one's attitude about not only homosexuality, but also conservative values and ideas that are the foundation of our land.

She writes of her experiences with the "Day of Silence," a day that honors homosexuals, and transgender and those who support them by allowing them to remain silent throughout the day. They do not have to participate in the classroom. She also tells of Eagle Forum's



battle and ultimate success in getting the Elk Grove school district to finally rule that the students could only participate in this day before, during lunch and after school – not in the classroom.

And she writes about another little known program named WEAVE, Women Escaping a Violent Environment, which gives a very biased presentation in the classroom showing a "power" chart degrading whites, rich, middle-aged, able-bodied, males and heterosexuals as the evil people who inflict violence on non-whites, poor, young, elderly, disabled, female, and homosexuals. Through an active Eagle Forum member, Teri Lawrence, the Sacramento chapter was able to get the WEAVE association to change the presentation and get rid of the most offensive and biased parts.

Georgiana describes the history leading to the pro-gay agenda in the public

schools today. The removal of the Judeo-Christian God from public schools and replacing Him with humanism and New Age paganism, which are both still religions, but somehow they are acceptable and allowed on campus under "separation of church and state" but Christianity is not.

She writes of the rise of homosexuality in Nazi Germany, and its rise here in America and the organizations that support it and protect it such as the ACLU and the NEA.

She tells of mind-control techniques being used to effect the paradigm shift to accept what one used to strongly oppose: the Hegelian Dialectic, praxis, and diaprax as exposed by a great Christian speaker Dean Gotcher. Through these techniques and trained facilitators people are brought to accept pre-conceived goals and objectives as if they were their own and are brought to consensus on issues that at one time they would have been opposed to. She writes how these techniques are being used not only in school settings, but also in the work place with "total quality management" and even in our churches through the "purpose-driven" movement.

These books are good companions to one another. *Seeds of Deception* presents the deceptive programs of indoctrination and social engineering that school children, teachers and administrators are facing, while *The Golden Rule School* gives a solution – a simple way of solving the problems schools face of discipline, violence, intolerance, teasing, bullying, without having to try one more new fad or untried program promoting more social engineering. When Is A Car More Than Just A Vehicle?

(editor's note—The California Department of Transport has recently proposed a "tax by the mile" for California drivers.)

Freedom of travel is something taken for granted in this country. No passports are required to go from coast to coast. Gas prices fluctuate but our destination and the routes we choose to take are a matter of personal choice.

Times are a-changing. Our nation is part of the international community now, and we are governed from the sky as well as the ground. Some of our troops along with commerce and trade are under UN control. We know about the NAFTA/GATT INTERNATIONAL HIGHWAY running from the Panama Canal through to the middle of America and into Canada. This 12 lane expressway for foreign imports has 42 trade corridor webs reaching out all across the United States.

But there were still some implementation facts missing. US taxpayers would be paying for this importation HIGHWAY by being taxed to travel their own roads.

How would this be handled?

An ABC radio announcement November 16 at 5:30 am talked about how the states of Wisconsin, Minnesota, Michigan, Iowa, and Illinois were going to be first in instituting a new type of tax based on road usage. Cars would be fitted with a transponder that works with the Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) The state computers are designed to link with the GPS and will bill the car owner for every mile driven.

This means every where you go, how long you stay, and when you return home will all be tracked by computer. As Virginia Meves (Director of "Wisconsin Report") stated, could this little box also record everything that is said in the vehicle, just as in airplanes?

More pieces are falling into place.

A research Prospectus, updated June, 2000, is titled, A New Approach To Assessing Road User Charges.

Although this Prospectus doesn't contain the words, UN or NAFTA/GATT

SUPERHIGHWAY one can detect these connections.

We know from experience that government studies are produced to justify something already implemented.

Originally we were told the Global Positioning System was for military use. Later it was announced the satellite would include other operations. Some were concerned about compromising military secrecy if the GPS was opened to other procedures. Further information makes it clear that monitoring people's travel was one of the "other uses" for this satellite.

The five mid-western states would be the prototypes.



This outline is a very technically complicated 10 page explanation of a Big Brother program.

We'll attempt to cover the highlights.

Claiming that the fuel tax is outdated and lacks revenue enhancement, the Prospectus indicates a change is needed. "Fuel taxes don't make vehicle operators realize the costs that a certain trip places on society. Government can't change driver habits such as not driving at peak hours by using fuel charges."

Control is the prime reason for changing the fuel tax to a "user tax."

The Plan

People traveling at congested times will pay a higher tax. Incentives will be presented for users to travel on appropriate roads, and to spread their trips across time periods. Issues such as congestion pricing will charge road users for air pollution. There will be segment-specific road pricing, and little chance of evading any imposed taxes.

Here the User Tax System and the NAFTA/GATT HIGHWAY programs began to fit together. They are one and the same.

Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) technology will be used to monitor special sections along the User roads. This same ITS system is also used on the NAFTA/GATT SUPERHIGHWAY. In addition, both the User system and the SUPERHIGHWAY feature electronic toll taking and SATELLITE technology.

"Appropriate roads" will channel US citizens away from the busy HIGHWAY webs bringing in imported goods.

We are told this will be a simple system. Here is how it goes. A computer is onboard which receives data from several sources and stores a record of actual road use. Periodically this record is downloaded and transmitted to a data processing center. The center bills the vehicle owner and reimburses the state Department of Transportation (DOTs), counties, and cities operating the roads on which the vehicle has traveled. See diagram

A "smart card" might be added for a rented vehicle. Trucks have a more extensive arrangement. Not only will the weight be measured each time the cargo doors close, but the configuration of the trailer, number of axles and the type of road traveled will be documented.

Specific-segment road charges will be levied by the political jurisdiction where the road segment is located.

This Prospectus fills in the details of pricing and routing that ties in with the SUPERHIGHWAY whose construction is controlled by the UN via the WTO.

It's not surprising that 2 of the 5 states involved in the first "User Tax" experiment are involved in designing the plan. The University of Iowa and the Iowa Department of Transportation were involved in both the NAFTA/GATT and User Tax studies. Iowa University serves as the lead institution, while the University of Minnesota handles other tasks for the New Approach To User Charges program. Both of these states

are important points along the NAFTA/GATT SUPERHIGHWAY.

A geographer Andrew Pietowski, received a message that the US Department of Defense had stopped blurring the signals from its Global Positioning System satellites. The systems were originally kept to low resolution to prevent enemies from targeting US facilities. A dream come true! This GPS would allow him to map the precise source of the Amazon River, something no one had been able to do. Trekking for days through rain forests, and inhospitable weather, suddenly the computer was plotting all the information onto a map. Mismi creek was the source of the Amazon. Andrew Pietowski said, "these are human feelings, and here we are supported by human technology-a connection of two worlds."

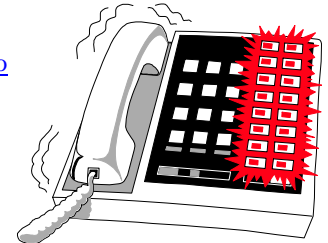
Isn't it strange how technology can be used to enlighten people on the one hand and take away their freedom with the other.

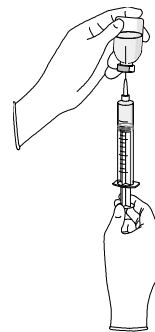
VACCINE NEWS

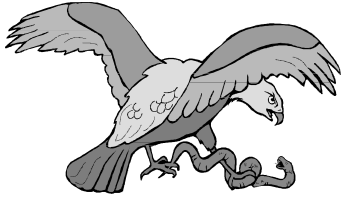
On September 3, a petition was posted online called "Show Us The Vaccine Data". Within 72 hours there were over 2,000 signatures. This petition shows the effects that vaccine reactions have on lives of families. The goal is 100,000 signatures. This petition will be presented to Secretary of Health Tommy Thompson. AB 2943, the Mercury Free Act of 2004 passed the Assembly on August 24th and Senate on August 25th.

This legislation strictly limited the amount of mercury in vaccines or products used by pregnant women and children in California. Governor Schwarzenegger signed this bill into law on September 28th.

If your child has had an adverse vaccine reaction, contact the **National Vaccine Hotline**. Their Vaccine Reaction Registry has been in operation since 1982.
