**Border Security Fence Stopped by Environmental Whackyism**

Congressman Tom Tancredo was thrilled with the passing of his tough new border control bill by the House on December 16, 2005. Along with provisions that he has long been pushing for, such as: slashing funds to localities that shield illegal aliens, punishing employers who attract illegals to the USA, making unlawful presence in the USA not just a civil offense but a felony, enlisting military and local law enforcement agents, the bill is asking for a security fence along the Mexican/American border.

However, there is a major problem in the Imperial Beach, California, area. Between Chula Vista and the Mexican border, two fences already exist, one right on the border and a secondary fence, situated about 150 feet north of the primary fence. The secondary fence suddenly comes to a mysterious halt, just where it is needed the most as it enters San Diego County. In past years most of the illegal crossings have taken place - an estimated 4 million a year. Why is the fence stopped? According to an interview November 4, with David Brown, Border Patrol Agent in Charge at the Imperial Beach Station, who gave a tour of the area to Georgiana Preskar, Eagle Forum Chapter Leader for Sacramento, and myself, the fence was stopped at that point because that is where federal land ends and San Diego County begins. A state agency, the California Coastal Commission, regulates construction and development within the 5 ½ miles of the coast of California. For “environmental” reasons the Coastal Commission does not want the secondary fence to continue across their coastal area. There is some concern about how the fence would harm an endangered plant called the baca bird bush. Supposedly San Diego county is the last remaining colony of the plant. They also state

that the construction of the fence would cause sedimentation to flow into the Tijuana Estuary. I asked Mr. Brown how the Coastal Commission feels about the trampling of their precious bush by hundreds of thousands of illegal immigrants crossing the area. If they are really serious about protecting their plant, wouldn't the fence actually provide much more protection than leaving it in open space where it can be easily trampled under foot? If the Coastal Commission is really serious about protecting the environment, would they not want to stop the huge amount of trash that is left by illegal aliens as they are crossing the borders, which is certainly harming the environment. The fence would put a stop to all that as well. Mr. Brown could not really speak for the Coastal Commission, but agreed that my questions made very good sense..Could there be some other agenda behind the stopping of the fence other than an endangered baca bush or estuary? Through my research and writing over the past ten years of environmental whackyism, I have discovered there is always a hidden agenda. Perhaps those behind the stopping of the fence have been given other marching orders by the federal government who seem to want millions of illegal aliens to keep crossing the borders, essentially as if our borders do not exist. Could this have anything to do with the blatant proclamation made by the Council on Foreign Relations (who have been the insiders running the federal government for many years) last summer that their goal is to have by the year 2010, open borders between Canada, Mexico, and the United States. Let us support Congressman Tom Tancredo in his Bill that was just passed by the House and urge our US Senators to also pass their version coming up in the new year. Just a year ago, Tancredo said he could count his allies in the House on two hands, but now a

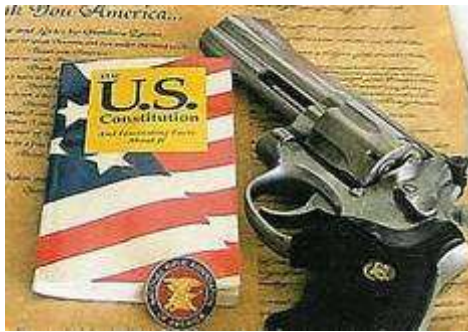

## Immigration Battle Moves to Senate in February 2006

### Summary:

The House of Representatives passed a true immigration reform bill in December. The legislative action now goes to the Senate, where pro-amnesty and more-immigration forces, led by Sen. Arlen Specter, will try to defeat what the House did.

California conservatives can help with phone calls, letters and faxes to senators.

### The House Legislation

Just before Christmas, an overwhelming bi-partisan majority attached strong amendment after strong amendment to H.R. 4437 before passing this tough immigration enforcement bill AND legal immigration reduction bill.

The *Border Protection, Antiterrorism, and Illegal Immigration Control Act of 2005 (H.R. 4437)* is a very good enforcement bill, that will require employers to use an electronic employment eligibility verification system; provide for a border fence along much of the U.S.-Mexico border; eliminate the visa lottery; and assist state and local law enforcement in arresting and detaining illegal aliens. Under heavy pressure from their constituents, the House passed the bill on December 16, 2005 by a vote of 239 to 182.

Now it is the Senate's turn to pass its own immigration legislation, which will likely include a weakened enforcement bill along with a massive guest-worker program and some form of amnesty. The Senate bill and the House's H.R. 4437 will be put in a Conference Committee of negotiators from both chambers. With heavy participation from the President, they will hammer out some kind of compromise.

### What to do Now

The web site [www.NumbersUSA.com](http://www.NumbersUSA.com) suggests that our primary message on calls and letters would be something like:

**Stop all efforts to include legalization or mass guest-worker programs in your immigration bill. Model yourself after the House and create an ENFORCEMENT-ONLY bill. Don't consider any other aspects until you have proven that the federal government can actually enforce the law. WE DON'T NEED MORE FOREIGN WORKERS.**

Start preparing their staffs to understand that the Senators' votes on this immigration bill will be widely followed and scrutinized -- especially votes by Senators who are running for re-election later this year. Senate leaders hope to pass their own immigration bill before March.

Senate sources are saying that Senate Judiciary Chairman Specter (R-PA) has a plan to force backers of tough immigration enforcement to accept amnesty and guestworker programs as the only way that Specter

will allow a crackdown on illegal immigration.

According to the web site, for some reason, Sen. Specter and his staff have come to believe that no matter how outrageous their efforts for creating open borders and flooding American communities with foreign workers, that the public won't really pay that much attention to them.

## The Battle for Student's Minds

Why are many taxpayers upset with our government's educational system? Business must produce a product that is salable or they go out of business. Those graduating from high school as well as college often aren't able to meet the requirements necessary to be hired for a job in the private sector. Of course this makes no difference in the continuation of government schooling because they operate under a monopoly.

In 1994, historians recruited by the U.S. Department of Education revised the history standards. Book publishers started centering their historical accounts of World War II on multicultural and diversity themes. The historical aspects of the battles and the military leaders who fought them were given scant notice. That is why some students today couldn't tell you who were allies or enemies in the Second World War. President Clinton didn't help matters by celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of V-E Day with Boris Yeltsin in Russia.

We progress through time and the Congressional reports by the Reese Committee were assembled in the book *The Foundations Their Power and Influence*. Among many different subjects that were investigated the Congressmen established the control of education by the Rockefeller, Ford and Carnegie foundations. Coercive forms of indoctrination were used. Colleges that didn't conform to certain dictates would not receive the large sums of largess from the Foundation organizations. The Foundations first targeted teaching col-

leges because the teachers would indoctrinate all those under their control.

Of course this change in education took time as the Foundations began introducing internationalism into the American curriculum while also adhering to the socialist agenda.

A survey found that about 90 % of college professors are registered as Democrats. To be more accurate many of these professors could be called radical liberals. This just follows the education indoctrination formula started by the Foundations years ago. Often professors will discuss subjects unrelated to the course just to impugn conservative people or causes. Due to the liberal connection among those who teach and hire, it is difficult for any conservative to become a professor in the political or social science world.

A former UCLA student of 2003, Andrew Jones has formed a group called the Bruin Alumni Association ([www.uclaprofs.com](http://www.uclaprofs.com)) This group is bringing charges against some of the biased partisanship professors. Students will be paid \$100 for ten weeks work that involves providing tapes or lecture presentations showing undue political or social bias in the classroom. This is not a large sum of money considering the time away from studies and perhaps outside paying jobs. Nevertheless, some former "Alumni" members have resigned because of the payment.

The combined information will be examined and then the designated professors will be approached with the evidence. Some

educators are calling this a "witch hunt" or "McCarthyism" phrases often used when anything rattles their educational arena. Students hesitate to disagree with liberal bias in class because the teacher has the last word in grading. Lectures are often recorded for study reference later on. So why the objections? Classroom teaching should be public domain since the universities and the professors exist on tax monies.

Still another deterrent to the teaching of history arises. The Corporation for Public Broadcasting, PBS, is enlisting media firms (usually left wing themselves) to help teach history with a television component. This would include middle and high school participants. Advantageous for the firms because they could get their commercialization into the system. Great for the PBS because with a public/private partnership they would be augmenting the tax monies already given. There is a need for reform on all levels of government's educational bureaucracy. PBS radio and the LA Times are viciously attacking any attempt to curtail the liberal ideology teaching at UCLA. ## Pro-Life Walk Attracts Thousands in Liberal San Francisco

Eagle Forum members Orlean Koehle, Lydia Key, Jonathan Krive, and Michael Arata were proud to be part of the 7,000 plus pro-lifers who participated in the second annual "Walk for Life West Coast" through the streets of San Francisco January 21, 2006.

After a one-hour program at the Justin Herman Plaza, the participants started walking down the Embarcadero to the Marina Green. Most of them were carrying signs provided to them that read "Abortion Hurts Women" or "Women Deserve Better than an Abortion." Other home-made slogans read: "Fathers Deserve the Right to Know Their Children;" "It's a Child, not a Choice;" "Planned Parenthood Kills for Money;" "Life Is a Gift," "Thanks Mom For Not Having an Abortion;" "Choose Life."

A few hundred pro-abortion protesters lined the sides of the street. Some were men dressed in women's clothing (one with a mustache). One man was dressed as a Catholic nun, calling himself "Sister Mary Timothy." Some protesters were chanting what their offensive signs were saying such as "Christian Fascism," "F--- the Unborn;" "F--- Your Agenda;" "Keep Your Rosaries Out of My Ovaries," "March for Life, That's a Lie, You Don't Care if Women Die." "The Christian Right is Neither;" "Abortion is Health Care - Health Care is a Right;" "Get Your Laws out of My Womb." "Not the Church, Not the State, Women Should Decide Their Fate." "Women Deserve Better - Women Deserve Choice;" "Women's Rights are Human Rights."

Some of the protestors had banners showing whom they represented: "International Socialist Organization;" "Peace and Freedom Party;" "Socialist Workers Organization;" "Code Pink. Many of them jeered and tanted the walkers. They were loud and confrontational. But as was instructed none of the walkers had any interaction or responded to the jeers. For our part, it was a very peaceful march.

### ***Pro-life speakers***

**Serrin Foster**, President of Feminists for Life, gave a short history of the women's movement, stating that many of the women who were fighting to gain the right to vote were God-fearing women who loved children and did not believe in taking their precious lives.

**Carol Crossed**, Vice President of Democrats for Life, said that 47% of democrats disagree with the party's platform concerning abortion and are pro-life. Even Hillary Clinton stated that "Every abortion is a tragedy." Carol said, "Democrats are supposed to be working against war, yet they are working for war in the womb. Democrats are supposed to be for the little guy, yet they trample on the littlest of all guys, the innocent, vulnerable, unborn child.

**Star Parker**, a Black Woman, formerly on welfare, who experienced several abortions herself, but is now a published author and the Founder and President of CURE, an organization to help women who have had abortions receive the help they need to get over their guilt and grief.

Star asked if the flag still flies over the "land of the free and home of the brave?" Do we have Americans who are willing to stand up against people who are committing such horrible injustices? ## Gay Marriage - Where Do Teachers Stand?

While pundits are debating whether “Brokeback Mountain” may herald acceptance of gay marriage, many taxpayers and teachers may be surprised to learn that almost a year ago the California Teacher’s Association (CTA) endorsed AB19 supporting gay marriage. Bill Collins, Legislative Advocate for the largest teacher’s organization in the state, wrote a letter to Assemblyman Mark Leno on February 18, 2005 in which he said, “The state has no legitimate reason to discriminate by prohibiting same-sex couples from marrying...use our endorsement of AB19 as may be helpful to its enactment.”

The Capitol Resource Institute asked, “What is the CTA doing lobbying for gay marriage? Why are union dues being spent to support this venture? The CTA’s own mission statement limits their involvement to issues affecting teachers as professionals. How is gay marriage an issue that professionally affects teachers?” In Collins’ letter he states that the endorsement was “voted by some 800 teacher-delegates from throughout the state.” But does this endorsement represent the majority of California teachers?

A Princeton poll conducted by Pew Research in July 2005 shows the majority of Americans continue to oppose gay marriage. As well, the majority of Californians oppose gay marriage. Five years ago over 60% voted for Prop. 22 which, “ensures ... that California will not permit same-sex partners to validly marry within the state. Without submitting the matter to the voters, the Legislature cannot change this absolute refusal to recognize marriages between persons of the same sex.” More recent polls show Californians still want marriage to stay between one man and one woman.

While Assemblyman Leno’s AB19, which would have altered the definition of marriage, ‘a union between a man and woman’ as adopted by the Legislature in 1977, failed by 4 votes, on September 7, 2005 the California Assembly, became the first in the nation to approve same-sex marriage, by voting in favor of another bill by Mark Leno, AB849. But this effort was stopped by Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger’s veto, because it did not represent California voters as expressed by Prop. 22.

Concerned that this is not the end of the battle for marriage, [VoteYesMarriage.com](http://VoteYesMarriage.com) is currently seeking to have California join the 18 other states that have amended their constitutions to ban gay marriage and is working to get a solid initiative on the ballot. Randy Thomasson of Campaign for California Families stated recently, “Whether for 2006 or 2008, [VoteYesMarriage.com](http://VoteYesMarriage.com) is devoted to giving the people the chance to protect marriage from the clutches of the bureaucracy.”

Still, the question remains, “Does the CTA speak for the majority of California teachers?” Does the NEA and other state teacher organizations speak for teachers across the nation? Frankly, it is difficult to determine as there is little documentation, research or polls, to accurately verify where teachers stand on this issue.

There is, however, a plethora of websites and articles pointing out the need for teachers to be trained on how to teach about the homosexual lifestyle, even in kindergarten, ‘hate crimes’ against gay students and teachers, and statistics by pro-gay groups about the negative attitudes of teachers that need to be changed. For instance, according to N.O.W. 85% of teachers oppose integrating lesbian, gay and bisexual themes in their curricula, and GLSEN reports 80% of prospective teachers report negative attitudes toward gay and lesbian peo-

ple.

I would appreciate information from anyone who knows of any valid research on where teachers stand on this issue.

In the meantime, let me ask California teachers, and teachers from across the United States: Are you in favor gay marriage? Do the delegates of your teacher organizations speak for you?

Will gay marriage become a reality in California, in America? The classroom is being used as a major battlefield for this issue. What side are teachers standing on? Please tell us. Voters and parents want to know.

Endnote: Currently in California AB606 is before the state legislature, which if passed will give the state superintendent unprecedented authority to withhold funds to any school district that is found to have violated ‘hate crimes’ as outlined in the bill.

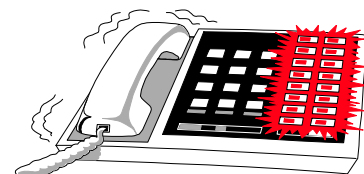

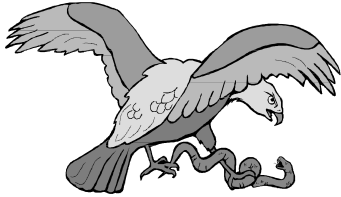
